

Eligibility

Social trips are available to eligible community transport clients (under Commonwealth Home Support Programme (CHSP) funding) that live in the suburbs listed. New CHSP clients aged over 65 will need to seek a transport referral through My Aged Care by calling 1800 200 422. Our group social trips cater to clients who are mobile, have low care needs, and relish the opportunity to explore and engage in activities outside the usual routine.
