Eligibility

Social trips are available to eligible community transport clients (under Commonwealth Home Support Programme (CHSP) funding) that live in the suburbs listed. New CHSP clients aged over 65 will need to seek a transport referral through My Aged Care by calling 1800 200 422. Our group social trips cater to clients who are mobile, have low care needs, and relish the opportunity to explore and engage in activities outside the usual routine. Priority is given to CHSP clients, however fee-for-service clients will be put on a waitlist and notified if there is an available spot.

Minimum trip numbers

Social trip times

The start time is when pick ups begin in the zone. Please be patient as you may not be the first client to be picked up. The end time is when the first return home begins. On the business day prior to the trip you will receive a text message or call advising of your estimated pick up time (30 minute bracket).

Payment

All social trips will be invoiced the month after travel.

Unless otherwise stated, the cost of meals, entry and purchases are not included in the price so please ensure to bring some additional funds for these purchases.

Vehicle

Please note that the vehicle used for social trips is a van. The van has 3 steps with a handrail. There is no bathroom onboard the vehicle, however longer trips have preplanned rest stops.
